# Hunt Information

## Hunt Closures:

DuPuis WEA is closed to the general public during days of the archery, muzzleloader, mobility-impaired, general gun, and spring turkey hunts. Only hunters may camp and enter the area on those dates. No horses are permitted in the campground and riding in the area is prohibited. When there is no hunting, the area is open to the public with vehicle access through Gate 1.

## General Gun Hog Hunts:

During general gun hog hunts, DuPuis WEA is open to the public, including hikers and horseback riders. All vehicles must enter and exit through Gate 1. Hikers may enter by foot at the trailhead at Gate 2. Hunters are allowed throughout the area and any legal weapon may be used. When the check station is staffed, hunters should check all game harvested.

## Small Game Season:

During the small game season, DuPuis WEA is open to the public, including hikers and horseback riders. All vehicles should enter and exit through Gate 1. Hunters are allowed throughout the area and only shotguns are permitted.

## General Information:

- Dogs: Retrievers and bird dogs may be used for hunting during the small game season only. No other dogs are permitted on the management area, including campgrounds.
- Alcohol: Not allowed in the campgrounds or the management area.
- Campgrounds:
  - Family Campground: Designated campsites and two composting toilets. Only tents and pop-up campers allowed at this site.
  - Equestrian Center: Restrooms with showers, RV dump station, no hookups. All RV campers as well as day-use or camping equestrians should use this area.
  - Primitive Campsites: Located along hiking trails. No facilities present.
