Section 120.74(1)(g)1., Florida Statutes – Licensing Activities of Prior Fiscal Year

Pursuant to section 120.74(1)(g)1., Florida Statutes, the enclosed information provides performance metrics on the South Florida Water Management District's (District) licensing activities for Fiscal Year 2025-2026 (July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2026), categorized by license type.

Under section 373.309(1)(b), Florida Statutes, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection delegated the water well construction permitting program to the District and the Florida Department of Health in 2004. The District subsequently delegated most of its well construction permitting responsibilities to eleven county health departments, retaining permitting responsibility only in Charlotte, Polk, and Monroe Counties and for wells 12 inches in diameter or wider in Broward and Miami-Dade Counties.

As a result of these delegations, the water well permitting data included here reflects only the permits issued directly by the District. Given this newly required reporting, the District will endeavor to obtain more comprehensive data for the following fiscal year's reporting.
