SFWMD to Host Water Shortage Compliance Workshop for Local Enforcement Officials

Water conservation remains critical to securing a reliable public water supply

WHAT:

In an effort to ensure compliance with water use restrictions, the South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) will host a water shortage compliance workshop for local government officials.

The workshop is designed to assist code and utility enforcement officers, law enforcement agencies and city, county and state attorneys with their roles in promoting and enforcing landscape irrigation water use restrictions. By statute, the enforcement assistance of all local governments is requested whenever the District declares a water shortage.

Workshop topics will include an overview of the water shortage order approved by the SFWMD Governing Board in September 2008, restrictions on specific use classes, violation forms and procedures, printed support materials provided by the District and reporting requirements.

Through the end of March, the 2008-2009 South Florida dry season is the third driest on record dating back to 1932. Water levels in the 16-county District are declining, and persistent dry conditions are forecast to continue through the remainder of the dry season. Dry conditions and the ongoing water shortage underscore the need for continued conservation to assist in maintaining the water supply. Ensuring residents and businesses follow landscape watering restrictions is critical to the effort.
