SFWMD, Golden Gate Task Force to Clean Green Boulevard Canal Cleanup is part of the District's Earth Day activities

WHAT: In support of Earth Day, the Big Cypress Basin Field Station, of the South

Florida Water Management District, is partnering with the Golden Gate

Task Force to clean up the Green Boulevard Canal this weekend.

Field station staff and Task Force volunteers will collect trash from the canal and transport it to dumpsters. District canals must be kept free of

debris to ensure water can flow for flood control purposes.

The effort is part of the 20th annual Bay Days, a cleanup event that draws hundreds of volunteers to Collier County waterways each year. More than

a dozen sites are being targeted for litter pickup this year.
