## S-65C Boat Ramp to Close Two Days for Repairs Erosion repairs needed for boat loading and launching

**WHAT:** The S-65C boat ramp will be closed on March 7 and 8 while the South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) completes repairs to ensure safe access for launching boats. The ramp is located off the S-65C access road between Cornwell and Lorida on the Kissimmee River.

> As an alternate, boaters can launch at the nearby Istokpoga Canal Boat Ramp located off U.S. Highway 98. The entrance to the Istokpoga Boat Ramp is 2.6 miles northwest of the intersection of U.S. 98 and the S-65C access road.

WHEN: The ramp is expected to be closed for repairs for two days: March 7 and 8.
