Kissimmee River Navigation Lock to Close for Repair Maintenance will help ensure continued operation

Okeechobee, **FL** – The S-65D Navigation Lock on the Kissimmee River will be closed to undergo repairs for 10 days beginning October 9.

The navigation lock, about 14 miles north of Lake Okeechobee, requires maintenance to the gates to ensure safe operation. The lock is expected to return to normal operation on October 19.

The flood control gates will continue to operate normally during the lock repair.
